



## Privacy Policy for Convention/Webinar/Event Participants

### Dear Participant to the convention/webinar/event,

Before you provide your data, you must read a series of information that will help you understand the reasons for processing your personal data, what your rights are, and how you can exercise them, in compliance with the provisions of the European Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 and Legislative Decree 196/2003 and subsequent amendments, known as the Privacy Code, whose objective is to protect the fundamental rights and freedoms of individuals.

### Data Controller

The **Data Controller** is **A.S.S.I. Gulliver Associazione Sindrome Di Sotos Italia Aps**, Via Giuseppe Saragat, 6 - 20128 Milano (MI), Mail: [info@assigulliver.it](mailto:info@assigulliver.it).

### Purpose of Processing

Your personal data is processed by the Data Controller for activities related to the organization, management, and to guarantee your participation in the convention/webinar/event to which you have registered or been invited.

Your personal data will be processed by the Data Controller for further related activities such as, for example: sending certificates of attendance, sending material discussed during the convention, sending thank-you notes for participation, etc.

Your personal data may be processed by the Data Controller for the purpose of **analyzing participants** to better structure and organize such conventions/webinars/events organized by the Data Controller. It is specified that, where possible, the Data Controller intends to process the data anonymously and does not intend to sell or communicate them to third parties.

The **legal basis for processing** is the registration form for the convention/webinar/event signed by you with the Data Controller Association; therefore, specific consent is not required.

### Communication and Disclosure of Data

In relation to the pursuit of the aforementioned purposes, your data may be transmitted, in addition to the individuals authorized to perform processing operations by the Data Controller, to **third parties** appointed to carry out the activities listed above and/or connected to the performance thereof, as well as to any parties who may carry out activities necessary for the pursuit of the legitimate interest of the Data Controller or third parties (e.g., the legal assistance of the Data Controller, etc.).

### Transfer Outside the EU

The Data Controller does **not intend** to transfer personal data to a third country or an international organization.

### Retention Period

Personal data will be kept for the period that allows the performance of the convention/webinar/event and the strictly

subsequent period to allow compliance with any auxiliary activities. In any case, your data will be kept for a **maximum of one year** from the end of the convention/webinar/event, except in cases where the Controller is subject to retention obligations for tax purposes or other purposes provided for by law or regulation.

### Processing of Special Categories of Data

We invite you **not to include special categories of data** (sensitive data), suitable for revealing racial and ethnic origin, religious, philosophical, or other beliefs, political opinions, membership in parties, trade unions, associations, or organizations of a religious, philosophical, political, or trade union nature, as well as personal data suitable for revealing health status and sexual life.

### Automated Decision-Making Process

The Data Controller informs the data subject that **no automated decision-making process** is in place, including profiling as per Article 22 of EU Regulation 2016/679.

### Data Subject Rights

The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation from the Data Controller as to whether or not personal data concerning them are being processed, and, if so, has the right to:

- **obtain access** to personal data, request the **rectification** or **erasure** of personal data, or the **restriction** of processing of personal data concerning them, or to **object** to their processing;<sup>1</sup>
- **receive** the personal data concerning them in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and has the right to **transmit** those data to another controller (data **portability**);
- be **informed** of the existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling;
- if expressed, **withdraw consent** at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent granted before the withdrawal;
- **lodge a complaint** with a supervisory authority.

### Nature of Data and Consequences of Failure to Communicate

The provision of data is **essential** for the purpose of processing them for the purposes indicated above. If data subjects do not communicate their indispensable data and do not allow processing, it will **not be possible** to participate in the convention/webinar/event organized by the Data Controller.
